## 16<sup>th</sup> International LS-DYNA Conference 2020: Call for Papers.

Stuttgart/Detroit, September 4th 2019

In cooperation with LSTC and Shanghai Fangkun, DYNAmore is co-organizer of the 16th International LS-DYNA Conference 2020. More than 950 participants and about 200 presentations make the event the largest LS-DYNA conference worldwide. The Call for Papers is already open. We are looking forward to numerous submissions until 30 October 2019.

All users of LS-DYNA are cordially invited to present their work, research results and experiences with LS-DYNA and LS-OPT to an international expert audience. This year, for the first time, speakers will have the opportunity to specify their preferred session at the time of submission. The venue is the second novelty this year besides the possibility to select the preferred session. The conference will take place for the first time at the Detroit Marriott at the Renaissance Center, centrally located downtown on the Detroit River.
